**Installation of Preschool Playground Equipment (Ages Birth - 3)**

Orchard View Schools invites proposals from qualified contractors for the installation of purchased surfacing and new equipment at a new Birth-Three aged playground at Orchard View Community Education Building.

A pre-bid meeting will not be held. The site contractor will be fully responsible for all required trades. Project details:

- **EXCAVATION:** Excavation of area for new play structure and concrete curbing.
- **CONCRETE WORK:** Installation of new concrete curbing for 74 linear feet
- **INSTALL:** Installation of small feats structure and hexagonal shade unit.
- **FENCING:** Supply and installation of fencing around new play area of 98 lineal feet
- Certification of renovated playground meeting State of Michigan licensing requirements for birth-three ages.

Due to the utilization of federal funds, **Davis-Bacon Act rules and regulations apply** to laborers employed directly upon the site of the work. DBA wage determinations may be found at <https://beta.sam.gov/>

**Sealed bids** should be submitted to **Orchard View Community Education, 1765 Ada Ave, Muskegon, MI 49442, no later than 2:00 p.m.** local time on **10-6-22**. Late bids will not be considered. Bids will be publicly opened on **10-7-22** at the Orchard View Community Education building in Conference Room 15 located at 1765 Ada Ave. Muskegon, MI 49442; evaluation of proposals and award will be at a later date. The project completion deadline is dependent upon receipt of priorly purchased playground surfacing and equipment. The anticipated receipt date is October 2022 (tentative).

Orchard View Public Schools operates on an equal opportunity/affirmative action basis in its bidding policy.
