- Ms. Vink is the Mentor Teacher for all 6th-8th graders and you **MUST** attend Google Meets **EVERY DAY**.
- Ms. Brackett is the Mentor Teacher for all 9th and 10th graders and you **MUST** attend Google Meets **EVERY DAY**.
- Mr. Bruno is the Mentor Teacher for all 11th and 12th graders and you **MUST** attend Zoom Meetings **2x each week**.
- **You should be checking your SCHOOL email EVERY day.**

- Grades for Edmentum courses will be entered into Power School at least once a week.
- If you are “On Pace” in Edmentum (Green Dude), you will see the “Current Grade” posted in Power School. If you are “Behind Pace” (Orange or Red Dude), you will see the “Course Grade” in Power School.
- You must spend a minimum of 5-6 hours each day on your courses
